40 Year Anniversary Message Thunder **OWNERS CLUB** 

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE BAY AREA THUNDERBIRD OWNERS CLUB!

EARLY IN 1958, SKIP AND JANE RIGGS BEGAN WORKING TO ESTABLISH A CLUB FOR THE OWNERS OF FORD'S FIRST MODEL OF THUNDERBIRD. THE RIGGS' RENTED THE OAKLAND BOATHOUSE AT LAKE MERRIT IN OAKLAND FROM THE PARK DEPARTMENT AND SPENT EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS PLACING POST CARD INVITATIONS ON THE WINDSHIELDS OF EVERY THUNDERBIRD THEY COULD FIND IN THE BAY AREA.

THE FIRST MEETING WAS HELD WITH SOME THIRTY INTERESTED THUNDERBIRD OWNERS ATTENDING. THE GROUP LIKED THE IDEA AND THUS A CLUB WAS FORMED WITH SKIP BEING ELECTED PRESIDENT: ART HORSFALL VICE PRESIDENT: DICK NAGLE TREASURER AND JANE RIGGS SECRETARY. SKIP DID THE EARLY NEWSLETTERS BUT SHORTLY AFTER FORMING, WE WERE JOINED BY ROGER NEISS, WHO WAS IN THE ILLUSTRATING AND PRINTING BUSINESS. WITH THE ADVENT OF ROGER, OUR PAPER WENT FROM A MIMEOGRAPHED SHEET TO A PROFESSIONAL LOOKING NEWSLETTER AND REALLY HELPED THE GROWTH OF THE NEW CLUB. OUTINGS WERE MOSTLY TOURS AND RALLY'S CENTERED AROUND THE THUNDERBIRD AUTOMOBILE.

ALMOST FROM THE BEGINNING, THE CLUB GRAVITATED TOWARD BEING HEAVY ON SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, WITH A PARTY OF SOME SORT AT ALMOST EVERY FUNCTION. IN THE EARLY DAYS, WE TOURED TO PLACES LIKE THE MARSH CREEK LODGE, OUR FIRST TOUR AND CLEAR LAKE WHERE WE SPENT THE WEEKEND AND HELD A GYMKHANA AND ALSO TO THE GOLD COUNTRY WHERE WE HAD SNOW TRIPS.

IN 1958, FORD ELECTED TO ENLARGE THE THUNDERBIRD TO A FOUR PASSENGER VEHICLE AND THIS BEGAN TO CAUSE STRIFE WITHIN THE CLUB. SOME MEMBERS AND WOULD BE MEMBERS WANTED TO ALLOW THE BIGGER CARS INTO OUR RANKS AS THEY WERE CALLED THUNDERBIRD, WHILE OTHERS FELT THAT THE ORIGINAL INTENT OF THE CLUB WAS TO BRING TOGETHER THE OWNERS OF THE TWO SEAT MODEL ONLY. THIS ARGUMENT RAGED FOR OVER A YEAR, FINALLY BEING SETTLED BY ALLOWING ONLY THE SMALLER TWO SEAT MODEL FOR MEMBERSHIP.

OVER THE YEARS, WE HAVE HAD QUITE A TURNOVER OF MEMBERS, SOME WHO HAVE STAYED WITH US FOR A YEAR OR SO AND SOME WHO HAVE BEEN ACTIVE FOR MANY YEARS. DURING THIS TIME, WE HAVE HAD SOME GREAT TIMES, MET SOME WONDERFUL PEOPLE AND GENERALLY ENJOYED THE THUNDERBIRDS A LOT MORE BY BEING IN THE COMPANY OF OTHERS WHO ADMIRE THIS UNIQUE AUTOMOBILE.

WE ARE NOW MET TO CELEBRATE OUR FORTIETH ANNIVERSARY. LOOKING BACK, IT IS HARD TO BELIEVE THAT THE CLUB HAS LASTED AS LONG AS IT HAS, THROUGH GOOD TIMES AND BAD. I BELIEVE THAT IS A TRIBUTE TO THE FAR SIGHTEDNESS OF FORD MOTOR COMPANY, THEIR EXECUTIVES AND TO FRANKLIN HERSHEY, THE FELLOW WHO CAME UP WITH THE DESIGN. IT IS TRULY A PLEASURE TO OWN AND DRIVE AND EVEN AT THE AGE OF FORTW SOMETHING, STILL INSPIRES OOHS AND AWHS BY LOTS OF FOLKS WHO STILL LOVE IT'S TIMELESS DESIGN.



July 22 and August 19<sup>th</sup> on a Sunday will be the Danville car show, the show starts at 10 and ends at 4




