

Tucker: The Man and His Dream is a 1988 American biographical comedy-drama film directed by Francis Ford Coppola and starring Jeff Bridges. The film recounts the story of Preston Tucker and his attempt to produce and market the 1948 Tucker Sedan, which was met with scandal between the "Big Three automobile manufacturers" and accusations of stock fraud from the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission. Joan Allen, Martin Landau, Elias Koteas, Frederic Forrest and Christian Slater appear in supporting roles.

Steve Tremulis is a biomedical engineer and the inventor of over 50 United States patents. He is also the nephew of Alex Tremulis, Preston Tucker's Chief Stylist for the Tucker 48, and he is the curator of his uncle's incredible archive of photographs, drawings, letters, speeches, and models from over a half-century of automobile design. Steve is an award-winning author on automotive history and a frequent guest speaker at various auto clubs and museums. Steve has served on the Board of Directors for the Tucker Automobile Club of America, and he currently serves on the Tucker Archives Committee for the AACA Museum, the new home of the Tucker Club.
